



### Module Aims:

To learn basic conversational Arabic

To be able to communicate with Arabs, listening, understanding and talking.

### Learning Outcomes:

- Demonstrate a basic level of competence both the language skills: aural and oral
- Express essential needs and deal with simple everyday situations in Arabic
